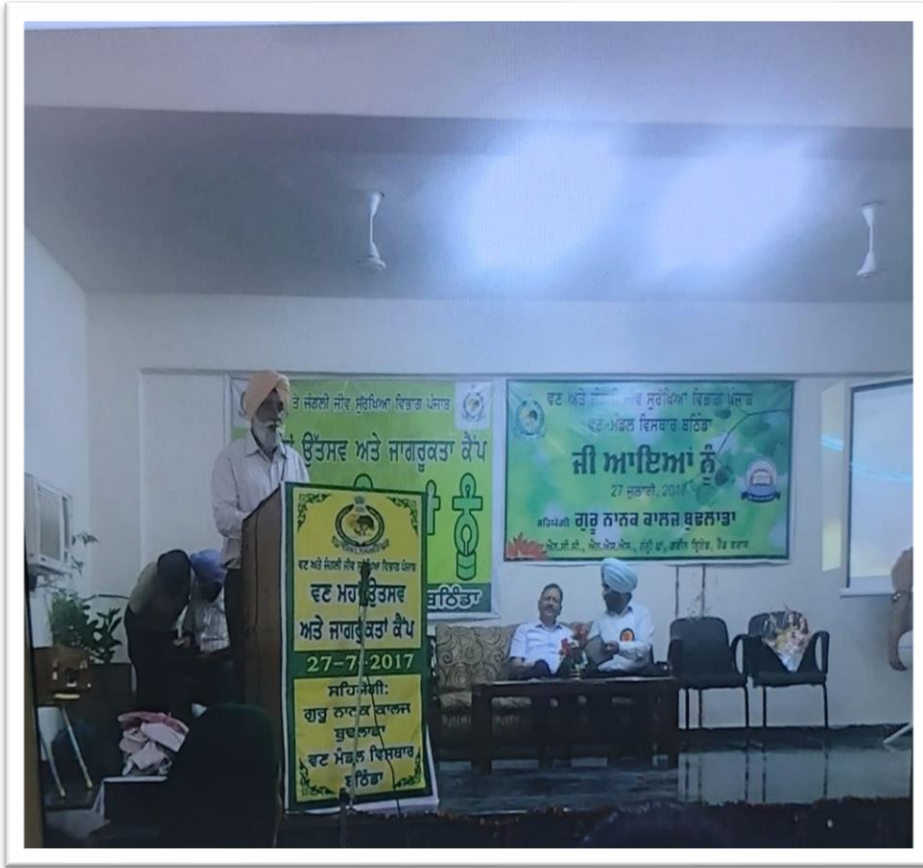

7.2 Glimpses of Institutional Initiatives/efforts for Best Practice: Awareness for Environment Conservation and Preservation during session 2017-18

Nanhi Chhan and Green Brigade Cell organised a programme in collaboration with Forest Department on 27 July 2017 on Van Mahotsav. The Officers from Forest Department spread light on the burning issues of environment pollution and motivated students to plant more and more trees.





Plantation in college campus was organised by Dept. Of History on 20-03-2018 to make college campus clean and green.



Tree Plantation was organized by the Department of Food Processing on 26th March, 2018. In this event students and faculty planted many types of plants to contribute in sustainable development and control of environmental pollution.



Department of Agriculture organized a guest lecture on “Sustainable Use of Natural Resources” for students. The speakers of the programme were Mr Ram Singh and Mr Ajay Tripathi (Members of *Kheti Virasat Mission*). In this programme students were encouraged to adopt natural energy resources (solar energy, wind energy etc.) instead of non-renewable sources of energy. They also added that students can play a significant role in environment conservation as the message “as an educated generation of digital age, they have the potential to revolutionize the mindset of society for the conservation of natural resources” can be accepted very generously.



An awareness programme was organized by Department of Agriculture to aware the farmers and students about the Crop Residue Management on 07-10-2017 at the village Tampura. The objective of the programme was to disperse the knowledge about new technology and advanced machinery equipment to manage Paddy straw instead of burning of crop residue. They also aware students and farmers about the ill effects of burning residue on atmosphere and how polluted gases adversely affect the human health and sustainability of natural resources.



Department of Agriculture organized “An Awareness Camp on Organic Farming” to motivate farmers and students about organic farming. The camp was held on 02-03-2018. In this programme experts shared their valuable views about organic farming methods to combine scientific knowledge of ecology. The principal approach of organic farming includes crop rotation, green manures, compost and biological pest control and using organics instead of using fertilizers and other chemical for enhancing crop yield were discussed.





Department of Agriculture organized one day awareness programme on Production and Importance of Use of Vermin-Compost for students and local farmers on 17 March 2018. In the programme vermin-compost prepared by Department of Agriculture was displayed and technique of production was shared with local farmers for promotion of sustainable farming.

A poster making and plantation was organised to Celebrate Sikh Environment Day by Department of Punjabi, Agriculture, Religion on 21/03/2018.

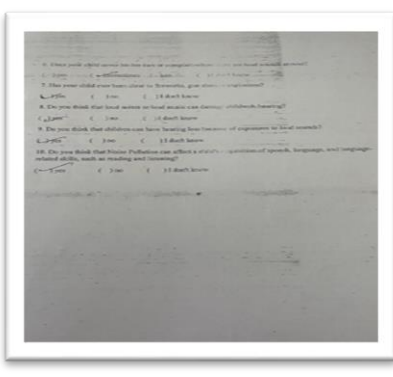
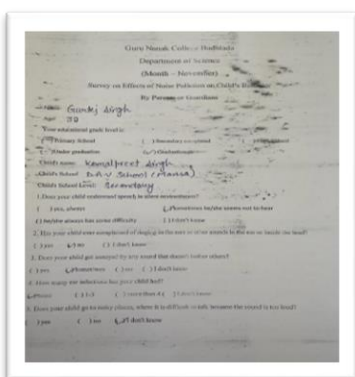

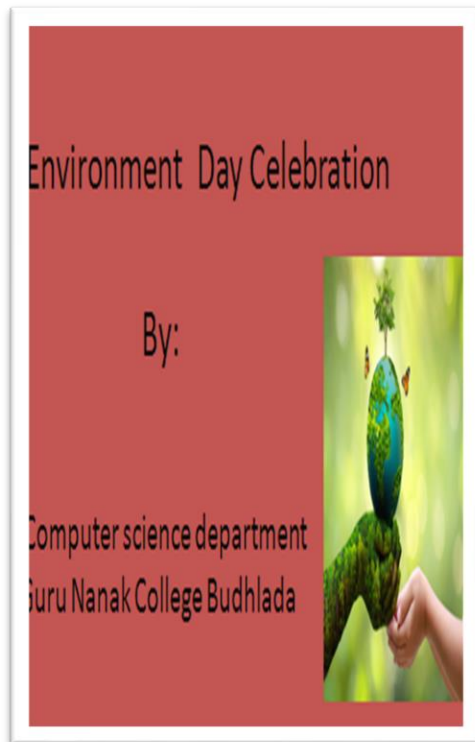
Speech Competition on Soil Pollution was organised By Dept. Of Pol. Sci. on 20-03-2018

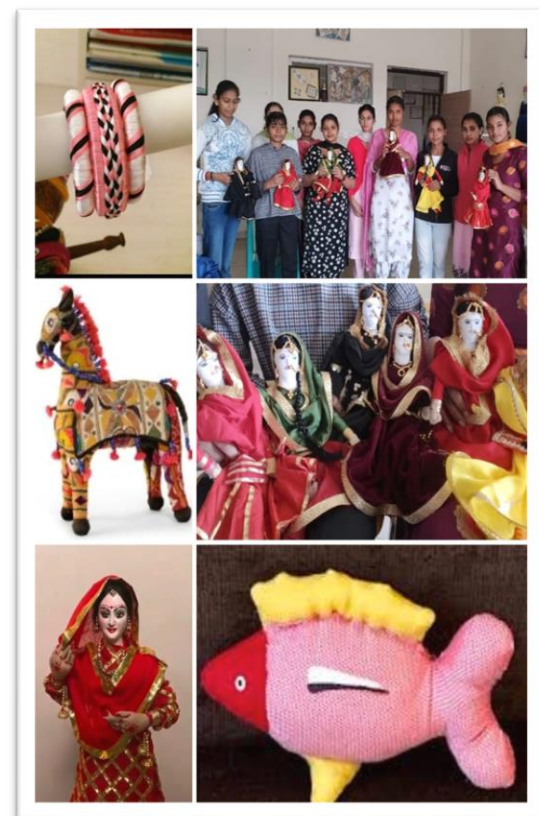
Speech Competition on Save Water was organised by Dept. of Math on 02-11-2017 to make students aware about the significance of water saving for future.
