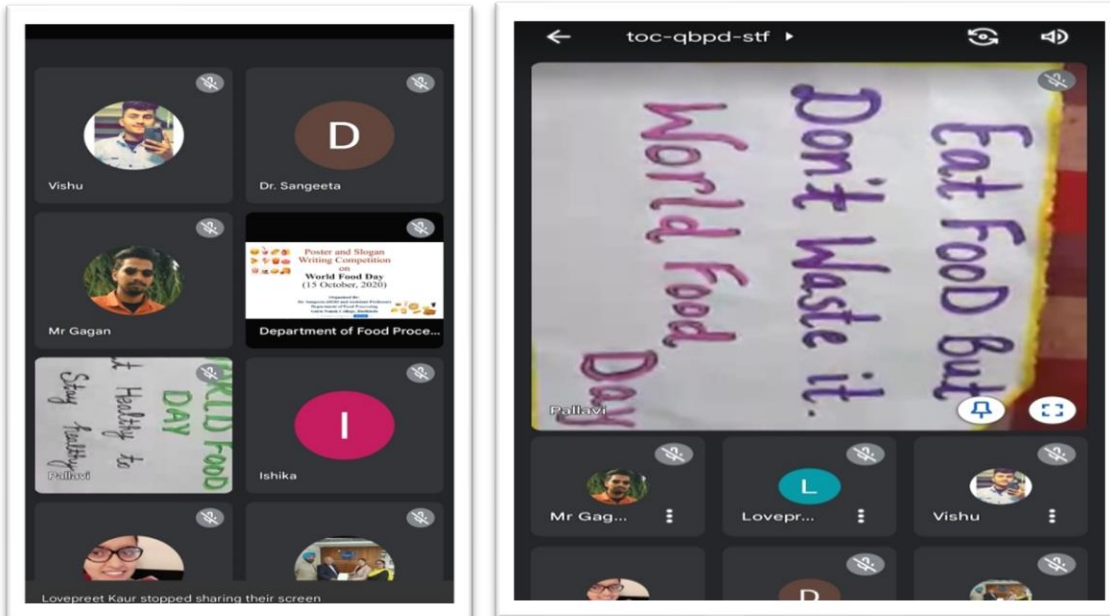
Department of English conducted a guest lecture on World Cancer Day on 2 Feb 2021 to make students aware about the environmental effects on the increasing cases of cancer.

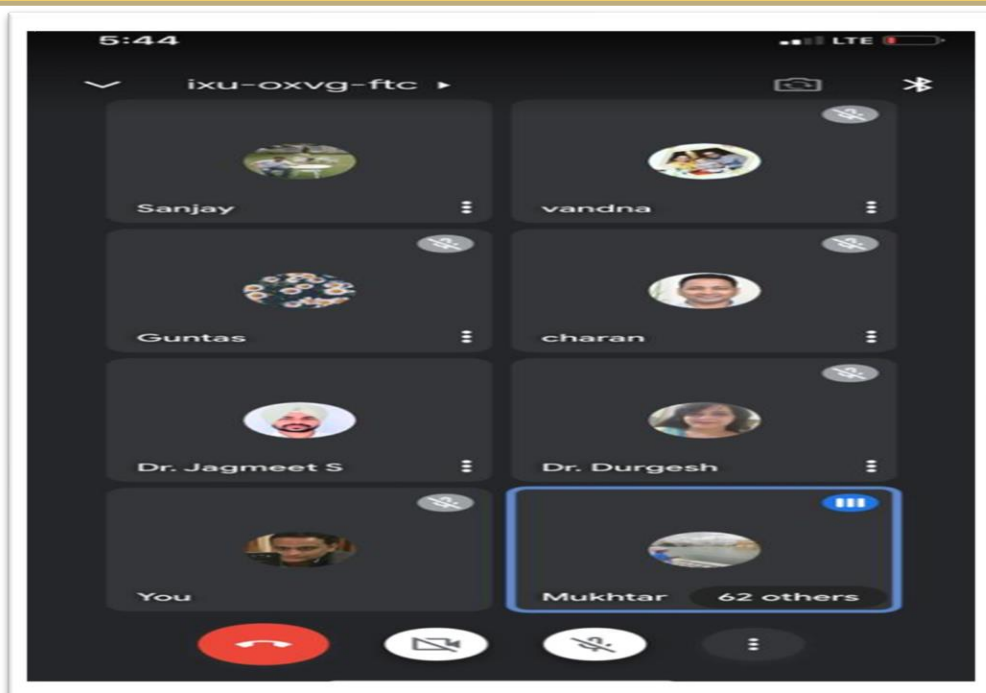
Thanks a lot to the entire team of Guru Nanak College for distributing masks, free food and help to the villagers by creating awareness during this pandemic situation.
